

2023 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1076

1 An Act to provide for supervised practice.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That chapter 16-16 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

4		The Supreme Court of South Dakota shall admit a graduate of the University of
5	<u>South</u>	Dakota law school to practice as an attorney at law in this state without taking the
6	<u>exami</u>	nation required by § 16-6-6, if the graduate submits a sworn, written application to
7	<u>the Sι</u>	preme Court that provides satisfactory evidence that the applicant:
8	<u>(1)</u>	Meets the qualifications of age and moral character as required by § 16-16-2;
9	<u>(2)</u>	Has been awarded a Juris Doctor degree from the University of South Dakota law
10		<u>school;</u>
11	<u>(3)</u>	Is a resident of this state;
12	<u>(4)</u>	Earned a passing score on the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination
13		as required by section 4 of the appendix to chapter 16-16; and
14	<u>(5)</u>	During the twelve-month period preceding the application for admission without
15		examination, completed one thousand hours of legal practice under the active
16		supervision of a member in good standing with the State Bar of South Dakota,
17		provided that the supervising attorney has practiced law in South Dakota for at
18		least five of the last seven years.
