- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions relating to the killing of any
- 2 mountain lion to protect human life, livestock, or pets.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 41-6-29.2 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 41-6-29.2. Any person, licensed or unlicensed, may kill a mountain lion if reasonably
- 6 necessary to protect the life of that person or some other person. Any person, licensed or
- 7 unlicensed, who owns or cares for livestock or pets, may kill any mountain lion posing an
- 8 imminent threat to such person's livestock or pets. The Department of Game, Fish and Parks
- 9 may promulgate no rule limiting the application of this section. If any mountain lion is killed
- 10 pursuant to this section, the person who killed the mountain lion shall notify a conservation
- officer within twenty-four hours of killing the mountain lion. However, the conservation officer
- may not confiscate the carcass of any mountain lion legally killed in accordance with this
- 13 <u>section</u>.
- Section 2. The provisions of this Act are retroactive to December 8, 2010.
