## HOUSE BILL NO. 1106

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize hunting preference points to be granted to
- 2 persons age ten years or older.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 41-6-12 be amended to read:
- 5 41-6-12. Any person who is a resident of this state, as defined by this title, qualifies as  $\underline{a}$
- 6 resident for securing any a resident hunting or fishing license or preference points point. All
- 7 other persons A person who is not a resident of this state, as defined by this title, shall secure
- 8 the an applicable nonresident hunting and fishing licenses license or preference points point.
- 9 No person under the age of twelve years may be granted any a hunting license or preference
- 10 point. However, any A person who is ten years of age or older may be granted a hunting
- 11 preference point. A person who is eleven years of age and who will become twelve years of age
- during the period of September first through to December thirty-first, inclusive, may be granted
- 13 any a hunting license or preference point and may be allowed to hunt beginning September first.
