- 11 South Dakota High School Activities Association. Nothing in this section confers any vested
- 12 right in any student wishing to participate in any interscholastic activity sponsored by the High

2	alternative instruction is deemed academically eligible to participate in any activity if the student
3	is in compliance with all requirements of alternative instruction pursuant to § 13-27-3. However,

6	enters an alternative instruction program is ineligible for participation in interscholastic
