1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to limit certain requirements associated with animal 2 identification systems. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That chapter 40-3 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as 5 follows: 6 The signature, participation, or involvement, whether voluntary or mandatory, of an animal 7 owner in any private or government-operated animal identification system or animal trace back 8 system, whether voluntary or mandatory, does not give any state or federal agency or employee 9 the right to enter property owned or leased by the animal owner without probable cause and a 10 search warrant, unless the agency or employee has permission of the property owner and the 11 animal owner. 12 Section 2. That chapter 40-3 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as 13 follows: 14 If, in the process of enrolling in or agreeing to participate in any animal identification

system, an animal owner is offered a contract allowing entry or access to property that the

- animal owner owns or leases, the contract may pertain only to that specific animal identification
- 2 system. The contract shall be clearly stated in layman's terms and shall refer explicitly to
- 3 property access. Any provision in which an animal owner agrees to use tags or to follow other
- 4 animal identification guidelines or requirements shall be part of a separate contract.
