## HOUSE BILL NO. 1146

1	FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Governor to enter agreements with Indian
2	tribes regarding the high school equivalency tests administered on Indian reservations.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
4	Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
5	The Governor of the State of South Dakota is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement
6	under the provisions of this Act and chapter 1-24 with any federally recognized Indian tribe.
7	The purpose of any agreement entered into pursuant to this Act is to allow the Indian tribes to
8	select the high school equivalency test that is administered at testing sites located within the
9	exterior boundaries of Indian reservations within the state.
10	Section 2. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
11	Any agreement reached pursuant to section 1 of this Act shall be for a term not to exceed
12	five years. An agreement, however, is renewable upon expiration by the mutual consent of the
13	parties.
