## HOUSE BILL NO. 1166

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the penalty for
- 2 identity theft while using an unauthorized credit card.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 22-40-8 be amended to read:
- 5 22-40-8. If any person, without the authorization or permission of another person and with
- 6 the intent to deceive or defraud:
- 7 (1) Obtains, possesses, transfers, uses, attempts to obtain, or records identifying 8 information not lawfully issued for that person's use; or
- 9 (2) Accesses or attempts to access the financial resources of that person through the use of identifying information;
- such person commits the crime of identity theft. Identity theft committed pursuant to this section
- is a Class 6 felony. However, if the unauthorized use of another person's credit card is used by
- 13 a person to commit a theft of one thousand dollars or less, the identity theft committed is a Class
- 14 1 misdemeanor.
