- No unit of local government as defined in § 6-1-12 may adopt, maintain, or enforce any
- 6 ordinance, policy, resolution, or similar enactment that prohibits, limits, or discourages a law
- 7 enforcement officer from communicating or cooperating with any federal agency or official in
- 8 the enforcement of immigration laws, including making inquiries about the immigration status
- 9 of a person under arrest.
- Section 2. That chapter 6-1 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- No unit of local government as defined in § 6-1-12 may adopt, maintain, or enforce any
- ordinance, policy, resolution, or similar enactment that grants to any person within the
- 13 jurisdiction of the unit the right to lawful presence or status in violation of state or federal law.
- 14 Section 3. That § 6-1-12 be amended to read:
- 6-1-12. As used in <u>sections 1 and 2 of this Act</u> and § 6-1-13, a local government unit is any

- 1 political subdivision of this state including a county, township, municipality, or other unit of
- 2 government, if the political subdivision provides local government services for residents in a
- 3 geographically limited area of this state as its primary purpose and has the power to act
- 4 primarily on behalf of that area.
- 5 Section 4. That chapter 23-3 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- No state, county, or municipal police department may adopt, enforce, or endorse a policy,
- 7 pattern, or practice that prohibits, limits, or discourages a law enforcement officer from
- 8 communicating or cooperating with any federal agency or official in the enforcement of
- 9 immigration laws, including making inquiries about the immigration status of a person under
- 10 arrest.
