- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow nonpublic schools to obtain state accreditation
- without adhering to any Common Core standards.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-3 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law, no nonpublic school seeking accreditation
- from the state pursuant to § 13-3-47, after July 1, 2013, may be required to align the school's
- 8 curriculum with any academic content standards that were proposed through the Common Core
- 9 State Standards Initiative, a state-led effort launched by state leaders through their membership
- 10 in the National Governors Association Center for Best Practices and the Council of Chief State
- 11 School Officers.
