## House Bill 1219

Introduced by: Representative Qualm

An Act to require certain health care professionals to recommend treatments alternative to opioids.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:
- 5 **34-20A-114.** Treatment of pain--Alternatives to opioids.

For any patient seeking treatment for a condition that causes pain, a health care professional, before prescribing an opioid, shall, based on the health care professional's clinical judgment and the availability of the treatments, recommend or prescribe for the patient any of the following treatment alternatives:

- (1) Physical therapy provided by a therapist licensed under chapter 36-10;
- 11 (2) Occupational therapy provided by a therapist licensed under chapter 36-31;
- 12 (3) Chiropractic services provided by a doctor of chiropractic licensed under chapter 13 36-5;
- 14 (4) Massage therapy provided by a therapist licensed under chapter 36-35;
  - (5) Acupuncture; or

16 (6) Participation in a chronic pain management program.

Nothing in this section requires all the treatment alternatives set forth in this section to be exhausted before a health care professional may prescribe an opioid for a patient.

Nothing in this section prevents a health care professional from simultaneously prescribing an opioid and recommending or prescribing any of the treatment alternatives in this section.
