## HOUSE BILL NO. 1251

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for delivery of alcoholic beverages to the
- 2 consumer by certain off-sale and package retailers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 35-4 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 35 regulating the sale, transportation, and delivery
- of any alcoholic beverage, any owner or employee, who is at least twenty-one years of age, of
- 8 a licensee licensed pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(3), (5), (12), (16), (17), (17A), or (19) or
- 9 chapter 35-12 may sell and deliver alcoholic beverages to any person in South Dakota to whom
- alcoholic beverages may be lawfully sold. Any sale and delivery made pursuant to this section
- shall be for personal consumption and not for resale and shall be made during normal business
- 12 hours. Any licensee delivering alcoholic beverages pursuant to this section shall hold a
- transportation company license pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(8). The individual delivering the
- alcoholic beverages shall require the recipient to demonstrate, upon delivery, that he or she is
- at least twenty-one years of age. The recipient shall sign an electronic or paper form or other

- 1 acknowledgment of receipt of the shipment of the alcoholic beverages. The individual delivering
- 2 the alcoholic beverages shall refuse delivery when the proposed recipient appears to be under
- 3 the age of twenty-one years and refuses to present valid identification. Each delivery of
- 4 alcoholic beverages pursuant to this section constitutes a sale in South Dakota and the licensee
- 5 shall collect the taxes due to the State of South Dakota and remit any excise, sales, or use tax
- 6 to the Department of Revenue and Regulation.
