- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to remove exceptions to certain health insurance policies.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 58-17-155 be amended to read:
- 4 58-17-155. Nothing in §§ 58-17-154 to 58-17-162, inclusive, applies to <del>nongrandfathered</del>
- 5 plans in the individual and small group markets that are required to include essential health
- 6 benefits under the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010, as in effect on
- 7 January 1, 2015, or to Medicare supplement, accident-only, specified disease, hospital
- 8 indemnity, disability income, long-term care, major medical policies with a limited duration of
- 9 less than twelve months, or other limited benefit hospital insurance policies, or any plan or
- 10 coverage exempted from state regulation by the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of
- 11 1974 (ERISA), 29 U.S.C. 18, as in effect on January 1, 2015.
