FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require reporting of the location of certain mine shafts
and tunnels.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The operator of any proposed or existing mining operation shall provide notice 5 of the location, as determined by an independent surveyor, of any lateral or horizontal mine shaft 6 or any tunnel in its operation to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources and to 7 each county in which the shaft or tunnel is located. The notice shall give the names of the parties 8 claiming the mine shaft or tunnel right; the actual or proposed direction of the tunnel or shaft; 9 the height and width of the tunnel or shaft; the course and distance from the point of 10 commencement of the tunnel or shaft to the endpoint of the tunnel or shaft; and the location on 11 the surface under which the tunnel or shaft runs.
