SENATE BILL NO. 103

Introduced by: Senators Tidemann, Bradford, and Tieszen and Representatives Munsterman and Hawley

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions concerning special alcoholic
2 beverage licenses issued in conjunction with special events.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 35-4-124 be amended to read as follows:

5 35-4-124. Any municipality or county may issue:

- 6 (1) A special malt beverage retailers license in conjunction with a special event within
7 the municipality or county to any civic, charitable, educational, fraternal, or veterans
8 organization or any licensee licensed pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(4), (6), or (16)
9 in addition to any other licenses held by the special events license applicant;
- 10 (2) A special on-sale wine retailers license in conjunction with a special event within the
11 municipality or county to any civic, charitable, educational, fraternal, or veterans
12 organization or any licensee licensed pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(4), (6), or (12)
13 or chapter 35-12 in addition to any other licenses held by the special events license
14 applicant;
- 15 (3) A special on-sale license in conjunction with a special event within the municipality



1 or county to any civic, charitable, educational, fraternal, or veterans organization or
2 any licensee licensed pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(4), (6), or (16) in addition to any
3 other licenses held by the special events license applicant; or

4 (4) A special off-sale package wine dealers license in conjunction with a special event
5 within the municipality or county to any civic, charitable, educational, fraternal, or
6 veterans organization or any licensee licensed pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(3), (5),
7 (12), (17A), or (19) or chapter 35-12 in addition to any other licenses held by the
8 special events license applicant. A special off-sale package wine dealers licensee may
9 only sell wine manufactured by a farm winery that is licensed pursuant to chapter 35-
10 12.

11 Any license issued pursuant to this section may be issued for a period of time established
12 by the municipality or county. However, no period of time may exceed fifteen consecutive days.
13 No public hearing is required for the issuance of a license pursuant to this section if the
14 organization applying for the license holds an on-sale alcoholic beverage license or a retail malt
15 beverage license in the municipality or county or holds an operating agreement for a municipal
16 on-sale alcoholic beverage license, and the license is to be used in a publicly-owned facility. The
17 local governing body may establish rules to regulate and restrict the operation of the special
18 license.

19 Section 2. That § 35-4-125 be amended to read as follows:

20 35-4-125. Any license issued pursuant to § 35-4-124 shall be issued to the person and the
21 location specified on the application. Notwithstanding § 35-4-2, the governing body of the
22 municipality or the board of county commissioners, as appropriate, shall determine the fee for
23 this license. Each application shall be accompanied by the fee ~~prior to consideration by~~ at the
24 time of submission to the governing body of the municipality or the board of county

1 commissioners. The fee provided for in this section shall be retained by the governing body of
2 the municipality or the board of county commissioners issuing the license.
