SENATE BILL NO. 115

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to ensure student privacy in public school locker rooms,
- 2 shower rooms, and changing facilities by restricting certain access.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-24 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 The term, biological sex, as used in this Act, means a person's immutable biological sex as
- 6 objectively determined by anatomy and genetics existing at the time of birth. A person's original
- 7 birth certificate may be relied upon as definitive evidence of the person's biological sex.
- 8 Section 2. That chapter 13-24 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 9 Each locker room, shower room, and changing facility located in a public elementary or
- secondary school that is accessible by multiple persons at the same time shall be designated for
- and used only by persons of the same biological sex. In addition, if a public school student is
- participating in a school-sponsored activity off school premises that may include being in a state
- of undress in the presence of other persons, school personnel shall provide separate, private
- areas designated for use by persons of the same biological sex, and no person may enter these
- private areas unless the person is a member of the designated biological sex.

- 1 Section 3. That chapter 13-24 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Nothing in this section prohibits a public school from providing accommodations such as
- 3 a family restroom, or single occupancy restroom or changing facility upon a person's request due
- 4 to special circumstances. In no event may the accommodation consist of access to a locker
- 5 room, shower room, or changing facility that is designated for use by members of the opposite
- 6 sex while persons of the opposite sex are present or could be present.
- 7 Section 4. That chapter 13-24 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 8 The provisions of section 2 of this Act do not apply to any person who enters a locker room,
- 9 shower room, or changing facility designated for members of the opposite biological sex if the
- 10 person is entering as follows:
- 11 (1) For custodial or maintenance purposes when the locker room, shower room, or
- changing facility is not occupied by any member of the opposite biological sex;
- 13 (2) To render medical assistance; or
- 14 (3) To prevent a serious threat to good order or safety during a natural disaster or
- emergency.
- Section 5. That chapter 13-24 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Nothing in this Act may be construed to prohibit a public school from adopting any policy
- 18 necessary to accommodate any disabled person or young child in need of physical assistance
- when using a locker room, shower room, or changing facility located in a public school.
