- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt motor vehicles owned by licensed ambulance
- 2 services from certain motor vehicle registration fees.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 32-5-42 be amended to read:
- 5 32-5-42. Any motor vehicle that is the property of this state, the United States, a county, a
- 6 township, a municipality, a public or nonpublic school accredited by the Department of
- 7 Education, an Indian mission school in this state, an Indian tribe, a fire department, a licensed
- 8 ambulance service, or any bus or van owned by a church may be registered upon application,
- 9 in the manner provided for other motor vehicles. However, the custodian of the vehicle shall
- make the application directly to the department. No fees may be charged for the registration of
- the vehicle. The department, upon payment to it of the actual cost of the plates, shall furnish
- number plates for the vehicle. All costs collected under the provisions of this section shall be
- deposited in the license plate special revenue fund. If the vehicle is used for a private business
- use or as a commercial motor carrier as defined in § 32-9-1, the operator shall secure vehicle
