- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the retention of state fiscal records.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

- 3 Section 1. That § 1-27-13 be amended to read:
- 4 1-27-13. The head of each agency shall submit to the commissioner of administration, in
- 5 accordance with the rules, standards, and procedures established by the commission, schedules
- 6 proposing the length of time each state record series warrants retention for administrative, legal,
- 7 or fiscal purposes after it has been received by the agency. <u>However, no state fiscal record may</u>
- 8 <u>be retained for less than ten years.</u>
- 9 Section 2. That chapter 1-27 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 10 For purposes of this chapter, the term, fiscal record, includes any document such as a bill,
- 11 receipt, contract, invoice, voucher, or grant agreement, in physical or digital form, that
- 12 documents moneys received, spent, or managed, and establishes an audit trail.
