

## 2024 South Dakota Legislature Senate Bill 14

## An Act to expand authorization for the conditional taking of coyotes from snowmobiles.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of South Dakota:

## Section 1. That § 32-20A-12 be AMENDED:

32-20A-12. No person mayExcept as otherwise provided in this section, an individual may not chase, drive, harass, kill, or attempt to kill any game animal or game bird $_{\iota}$ with or from a snowmobile, except that coyotes may be taken by a landowner of lessee on the landowner's property by shooting from stationary snowmobiles through the use of firearms if the operator of the snowmobile is at least eighteen years of age. Not more than one person may be aboard the snowmobile while coyotes are being hunted of taken pursuant to this-section.

The prohibition of this section does not apply to an individual using a snowmobile in the taking of a coyote if:
(1) The individual is on property that the individual owns or leases or the individual is on the property as an invitee of the owner or lessee;
(2) The individual is at least eighteen years of age;
(3) The individual is using a firearm to take the coyote;
(4) The snowmobile is stationary at the time the individual shoots or attempts to shoot the coyote; and
(5) No other individual is aboard the snowmobile.

A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
