- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That ARSD 67:10:01:13 be repealed.
- 5 67:10:01:13. Individual ineligible if convicted of certain offenses. An individual is
- 6 ineligible for assistance under this article if the individual is convicted of a felony under federal
- 7 or state law which felony has as an element the possession, use, or distribution of a controlled
- 8 substance. An individual applying for assistance must, during the application process, state in
- 9 writing on a form available from the department whether the individual or any member of the
- 10 individual's household has been convicted of such a crime. This section does not apply to
- 11 convictions which occurred before August 23, 1996.
- 12 Section 2. That chapter 28-7A be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- Pursuant to section 21 U.S.C. § 862a(d)(1)(A), South Dakota opts out of the provisions of
- 14 section 21 U.S.C. § 62a(a)(1).
- A person with a felony conviction under state or federal law may be eligible to receive
