1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Brand Board to establish a service fee for 2 certain local inspections of livestock and to declare an emergency. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 40-18-16 be amended to read as follows: 5 40-18-16. The board may promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 to: 6 (1) Describe prohibited brand symbols for various types of livestock and identify locations on animals where a brand is permitted; 8 (2) Provide for the registration, transfer, and renewal of livestock brands; (3) Establish a brand registration fee not to exceed twenty-five dollars; 10 (4) Establish a brand renewal fee not to exceed ten dollars per year or a brand renewal 11 fee not to exceed fifty dollars for each five-year ownership period and a brand 12 transfer fee not to exceed twenty-five dollars; 13 (5) Establish an ownership inspection fee not to exceed one dollar for each head of 14 livestock; 15 (6) Establish recordable livestock brands;

1	(7)	Establish law enforcement, ownership inspection, and transportation requirements
2		within or without the ownership inspection area;
3	(8)	Establish a duplicate certificate fee not to exceed five dollars;
4	(9)	Establish a mileage fee for inspectors not to exceed the rate set by the State Board of
5		Finance; and
6	<u>(10)</u>	Establish a fee for local inspections of one hundred head of livestock or less, not to
7		exceed twenty-five dollars per trip.
8	Section	on 2. That chapter 40-20 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
9	follows:	
10	The board may charge and collect a fee for services pertaining to any local inspection of one	
11	hundred head of livestock or less as required by chapters 40-20 and 40-21. The fee shall be in	
12	addition to the ownership inspection fee and the mileage fee, and shall be used to offset the costs	
13	of providing a local inspection.	
14	Section	on 3. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
15	existing p	public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in

full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
