1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the definition of individuals with a serious 2 emotional disturbance. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 27A-15-1.1 be amended to read: 5 27A-15-1.1. For the purposes of this chapter, an individual with a serious emotional 6 disturbance is an individual who: 7 (1) Is under eighteen years of age; 8 (2) Exhibits behavior resulting in functional impairment which substantially interferes 9 with, or limits the individual's role or functioning in the community, school, family, 10 or peer group; 11 (3) Has a mental disorder diagnosed under the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of 12 Mental Disorders, fifth edition, 2013, or coding found in the International Classification of Diseases, 10th revision, Clinical Modification, 2015; 13 14 (4) Has demonstrated a need for one or more special care services, in addition to mental 15 health services; and

- 1 (5) Has problems with a demonstrated or expected longevity of at least one year or has
- 2 an impairment of short duration and high severity.
- 3 For purposes of this section, intellectual disability, epilepsy, other developmental disability,
- 4 alcohol or substance abuse, brief period of intoxication, or criminal or delinquent behavior do
- 5 not, alone, constitute a serious emotional disturbance.
