## HOUSE ENGROSSED NO. **SB 53** - 03/11/2014

**This bill has been extensively amended (hoghoused) and may no longer be consistent with the original intention of the sponsor.**

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Department of Labor and Regulation

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make appropriations to fund certain programs and  
2 projects that provide economic benefits to South Dakotans and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund, the sum of one million dollars  
5 (\$1,000,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the South Dakota Board of Water and  
6 Natural Resources for the purpose of providing advance federal funds for the construction of  
7 the facilities included in the Lewis and Clark Rural Water System as authorized in  
8 § 46A-1-13.10. Funds shall be provided according to terms and conditions established by the  
9 Board of Water and Natural Resources.

10 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall  
11 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by  
12 section 1 of this Act.

13 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund, the sum of five hundred  
14 thousand dollars (\$500,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Governor's Office



1 of Economic Development for the purpose of funding the Readiness and Environmental  
2 Protection and Integration (REPI) buffer program at Ellsworth Air Force Base.

3 Section 4. The commissioner of the Governor's Office of Economic Development shall  
4 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by  
5 section 3 of this Act.

6 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund, the sum of four hundred  
7 sixty-four thousand dollars (\$464,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Board  
8 of Regents for the purpose of funding a shale research facility at the South Dakota School of  
9 Mines and Technology.

10 Section 6. The executive director of the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the  
11 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by section 5 of this Act.

12 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of five hundred  
13 thousand dollars (\$500,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the state aeronautics  
14 fund for the purposes of airport improvements.

15 Section 8. The secretary of the Department of Transportation shall approve vouchers and  
16 the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by section 7 of this Act.

17 Section 9. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by  
18 June 30, 2015, shall revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

19 Section 10. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its  
20 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in  
21 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
