- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for the use of certain general funds to increase
- 2 Medicaid reimbursement rates for existing Medicaid providers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That the code be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 After a portion of any state general fund savings obtained from additional federal funding
- 6 for services received through an Indian Health Service or tribal facility and furnished to
- 7 Medicaid-eligible American Indians is shared with the Indian Health Service and the other
- 8 parties to coordinated care agreements, at least eighty percent of the remaining savings shall be
- 9 used to increase the Medicaid reimbursement rates for existing Medicaid programs.
