- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the lawful possession
- 2 of firearms in certain locations.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 22-14 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 5 No building, structure, park, campus, or other area may be posted as a firearm-free zone
- 6 unless any person entering the area is required to pass through an electronic device to detect the
- 7 presence of a firearm on the body of that person or unless personnel trained by the entity or a
- 8 delegate of the entity posting the area are located in the area. The provisions of this section do
- 9 not apply to:
- 10 (1) Any county courthouse;
- 11 (2) The state capitol; or
- 12 (3) Any law enforcement office or building.
