SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes up to two owners of a limited liability company (LLC) that owns property within a municipality, to vote in that municipality's elections if the municipal charter provides for property rights voting.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 2-2-107(a)(1), a person is registered to vote in the precinct in which the person resides, and may also be registered to vote in a municipality in which the person owns real property to vote in that municipality's elections.
- The proposed legislation would authorize up to two owners of an LLC to vote in the municipality's elections in which the property is located.
- The Division of Elections can verify an owner of an LLC seeking to vote in a municipality's election owns property in that municipality within existing resources.
