HB 2888 - SB 2689

SUMMARY OF BILL: Deletes a duplicate provision authorizing Nashville Shores to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- This legislation deletes Tenn. Code Ann. § 57-4-102(27)(FF) which states that a development with 385 acres on J. Percy Priest Lake, has a water park, and is located in a county having a population of not less than 500,000, according to the 2000 federal census is considered a “premier type tourist resort” for the purpose of selling alcoholic beverages on-premises.
- Similar provisions, having the same effect, are detailed in Tenn. Code Ann. § 57-4-102(27)(GG); therefore, removal of code which permits the same institution to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption is estimated to be not significant.
