

HOUSE BILL 178

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57,
relative to alcoholic beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102, is amended by adding the following new subdivision:

() "Corporation," unless the context otherwise requires, includes an incorporated city or town;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-5-101, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

() As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires, "corporation" includes an incorporated city or town.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(28), is amended by adding the following new subdivision:

(i) A municipality that:

(a) Contains a tourism development zone;

(b) Is the county seat of a tourist resort county, as that term is defined in § 42-1-301;

(c) Owns and operates a thirty-six-hole golf course; and

(d) Owns and operates a restaurant;

(ii) The premises of a municipality designated under this subdivision (28)() means any or all of the property that constitutes the premises. The licensee shall designate the premises to be licensed by the commission by filing a drawing of the

premises, which may be amended by the licensee filing a new drawing. The designated premises may only include property owned or leased by the municipality. The entire designated premises is covered under one (1) license issued under this subdivision (28)(); and

(iii) Notwithstanding any provision of chapter 5 of this title to the contrary, the premises of a municipality licensed under this subdivision (28)() means, for beer permitting purposes, any or all of the property that constitutes the premises designated under subdivision (28)()(A)(ii). The beer permittee shall designate the premises to be permitted by the local beer board by filing a drawing of the premises, which may be amended by the beer permittee filing a new drawing. The entire designated premises is covered under one (1) beer permit issued under chapter 5 of this title;

SECTION 4. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
