## **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 425**

**SENATE BILL NO. 414**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 8 and Title 49, relative to K-12 education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-36-805, is amended by deleting subdivision (3) and substituting instead the following:

(3) The retired member may work in addition to the one hundred twenty (120) days prescribed above if employed as a substitute teacher in a public school system; provided, that the compensation payable to the retired member for such work does not exceed the rate of compensation set by the public school system for substitute teachers filling similar vacant positions, and the total salary paid to any such retired member for teaching during the twelve-month period does not exceed the pertinent pro rata share of average salary being paid at the institution in the academic discipline concerned;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-36-821(a), is amended by deleting subdivisions (2), (3), and (7).

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-36-822, is amended by deleting subdivisions (a)(4) and (a)(7)(B), and by deleting subsection (b).

SECTION 4. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
