HOUSE BILL 1350

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 12, relative to appointment of an administrator of elections.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-12-116(1), is amended by inserting following language after the first sentence of the subdivision:

The term of the administrator of elections shall be for two (2) years and shall begin on

the first Monday in April of each odd-numbered year. An administrator of elections may

continue to hold office until a successor is appointed by the commission.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-12-116(1), is further amended by

deleting the semicolon at the end of the subdivision and substituting instead the following

language:

. The commission may consider political party affiliation when appointing an

administrator of elections;

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
