

HOUSE BILL 2363

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39  
and Title 40, relative to crimes involving substance  
abuse.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. This act is known and may be cited as "Ledford's Law."

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-213(b)(2), is amended by deleting the language "on probation pursuant to § 40-35-303" wherever it appears.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-28-117(a), is amended by adding the following new subdivision:

(3) The terms and conditions of parole for a prisoner convicted of vehicular homicide, under § 39-13-213(a)(2), or aggravated vehicular homicide, under § 39-13-218, must specifically include that the prisoner, upon release, attend substance-abuse treatment for the duration of any period of parole. Attendance at substance-abuse treatment shall be a condition of parole, and failure to attend shall be punished as a violation of the conditions of the defendant's parole.

SECTION 4. This act takes effect July 1, 2024, the public welfare requiring it.
