

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 754

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Angie Box to the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-7-104(a), provides for the creation of the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-7-104(b), provides that the governor shall appoint eleven members to the board; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Angie Box as a member of the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board representing West Tennessee, to a term that will expire on October 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Box is an active community member in the Jackson-Madison County area; she has a background in real estate, and she attended Lambuth University and the University of Tennessee at Martin, where she earned a Bachelor of Science degree; and

WHEREAS, she is a member of the Quality Deer Management Association, Deer River Retriever Club, the NRA, and All Saints Church; additionally, she served on the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission for six years, finishing her term as chair; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Box is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-7-104(b)(2), provides that each member appointed by the governor to the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board shall be confirmed by joint resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE

CONCURRING, that this body does hereby confirm the appointment of Angie Box to the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board for a term that will expire on October 31, 2025.
