

SENATE BILL 389

AN ACT to name a bridge on State Route 227 in Wayne County in honor of the late Joe "Buddy" Bailey.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the bridge on State Route 227 in Wayne County that is approximately three hundred feet (300') east from 5804 Pumping Station Road is hereby designated the "Joe 'Buddy' Bailey Memorial Bridge".

SECTION 2. The department of transportation is directed to erect suitable signs or to affix suitable markers designating the bridge described in Section 1 as the "Joe 'Buddy' Bailey Memorial Bridge".

SECTION 3. The erection of such signs shall be within the guidelines prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

SECTION 4. This act shall become operative only if the federal highway administrator advises the commissioner of transportation in writing that the provisions of this act shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations and subject to penalties prescribed therein.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
