AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 37; Title 49 and Title 55, relative to fees for driver licenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-50-312, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

(h) A person under eighteen (18) years of age in custody of the department of children's services shall not be charged a fee for issuance, renewal, or reinstatement of a driver license, instruction permit, intermediate driver license, or photo identification card. The application must be accompanied by evidence that the person is in such custody.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect January 1, 2024, the public welfare requiring it, and applies to applications for issuance, renewal, or reinstatement received on or after such date.
