## **SENATE BILL 1317**

## By Bailey

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39; Title 40 and Title 71, Chapter 6, relative to criminal offenses.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-35-313(a)(1)(B)(i)(c), is amended by deleting the subdivision and substituting instead:

- (c) Is not seeking deferral of further proceedings for:
  - (1) A sexual offense;
- (2) Financial exploitation of an elderly or vulnerable person, as prohibited by § 39-15-502;
- (3) Aggravated neglect of an elderly or vulnerable adult, as prohibited by § 39-15-508, or aggravated abuse of an elderly or vulnerable adult, as prohibited by § 39-15-511; provided, however, that a healthcare provider, as defined in § 63-1-168, who commits such an offense in the course of the provider's official duties and the offense was not committed intentionally, is not prohibited from being a qualified defendant;
- (4) Sexual exploitation of an elderly or vulnerable adult, as prohibited by § 39-15-512;
- (5) Driving under the influence of an intoxicant, as prohibited by § 55-10-401;
- (6) Vehicular assault, as prohibited by § 39-13-106, prior to service of the minimum sentence required by § 39-13-106; or
  - (7) A Class A or B felony;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-35-313(a)(1)(B)(ii), is amended by deleting the language "As used in subdivision (a)(1)(B)(i)(c)" and substituting "As used in subdivision (a)(1)(B)(i)(c)(1)".

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
