AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55 and Section 67-6-303, relative to the purchase of motor vehicles by members of the military.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-6-303(a)(3), is amended by deleting the subdivision and substituting instead the following:

(3) A member of the Tennessee national guard, or a reserve member of a uniformed service of the United States, who has been called into active military service of the United States, as defined in § 58-1-102, and is deployed under orders to a duty station in another state or another country. For such member, the exemption provided in this subdivision (a)(3) applies from the effective date of official military orders deploying the member to a duty station in another state or another state or another state or another country and expires ninety (90) days after the effective date of official military orders releasing the member from the deployment.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2024, the public welfare requiring it.
