AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 13, Part 5, relative to aggravated rape of a child.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-531, is amended by deleting the language "if the victim is three (3) years of age or less" and substituting instead the language "if the victim is eight (8) years of age or less".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-522, is amended by deleting the language "three (3) years of age" and substituting instead the language "eight (8) years of age".

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020, the public welfare requiring it.
