SENATE BILL 1963

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 6, relative to school attendance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 30, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

- (a) Notwithstanding this part, a student who begins grade nine (9) in a public or nonpublic high school shall attend a public or nonpublic high school for four (4) full school years, unless the student:
 - (1) Is excused from compulsory attendance under § 49-6-3005;
 - (2) Received a diploma or other certificate of graduation issued to the student by a secondary high school;
 - (3) Is enrolled and making satisfactory progress in a course leading to a GED® or HiSET® from a state-approved institution or organization, or has obtained a GED® or HiSET®;
 - (4) Is seventeen (17) years of age or older and enrolled in a home school; or
 - (5) Successfully completed an early high school graduation program under the Move On When Ready Act, compiled in part 81 of this chapter.
- (b) As used in this section, "nonpublic school" and "public school" have the same meanings as defined in § 49-6-3001.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and applies to the 2022-2023 school year and subsequent school years.
