

SENATE BILL 2200

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4,  
Chapter 3, Part 16; Title 33 and Title 49, Chapter  
6, relative to health funding for K-12 students.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 6, Part 61, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

**49-6-6102.**

The department of education, in coordination with the department of mental health and substance abuse services, shall annually submit a report to the education committees of the senate and house of representatives regarding state-funded mental and behavioral health services available to elementary and secondary school students. The report must include recommendations, if any, for improving the services, and must be submitted to the education committees on or before December 31 of each year.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
