AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 63, relative to osteopathic physicians.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-9-101, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection (e):

(e) The board is authorized to issue advisory private letter rulings to an affected licensee who makes such a request regarding matters within the board's primary jurisdiction. The private letter ruling only affects the licensee making the inquiry and has no precedential value for another inquiry or future contested case that might come before the board. The board may resolve a dispute regarding a private letter ruling pursuant to the declaratory order provisions of § 4-5-223.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
