AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 15, Chapter 2, relative to Women's Suffrage Day.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 15, Chapter 2, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

August 18 of each year is to be observed as "Women's Suffrage Day".

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
