

## **PRIVATE CHAPTER NO. 43**

**SENATE BILL NO. 2939**

AN ACT to amend Chapter 25 of the Private Acts of 2009; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the Clay County hotel-motel tax.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 25 of the Private Acts of 2009, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting the language "two and one-half percent (2.5%)" in Section 2 and substituting instead the language "four percent (4%)".

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Clay County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
