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## A BILL

To amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to repeal certain limitations on health care benefits.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Family Health Care  
5 Flexibility Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF DISTRIBUTIONS FOR MEDICINE QUALI-**  
2 **FIED ONLY IF FOR PRESCRIBED DRUG OR IN-**  
3 **SULIN.**

4 Section 9003 of the Patient Protection and Afford-  
5 able Care Act (Public Law 111–148) and the amendments  
6 made by such section are repealed; and the Internal Rev-  
7 enue Code of 1986 shall be applied as if such section, and  
8 amendments, had never been enacted.

9 **SEC. 3. REPEAL OF LIMITATION ON HEALTH FLEXIBLE**  
10 **SPENDING ARRANGEMENTS UNDER CAFE-**  
11 **TERIA PLANS.**

12 Sections 9005 and 10902 of the Patient Protection  
13 and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111–148) and sec-  
14 tion 1403 of the Health Care and Education Reconcili-  
15 ation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–152) and the amend-  
16 ments made by such sections are repealed.

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
