A BILL

To prohibit foreign assistance to Pakistan until the tuition assistance program of the Department of Defense is fully funded.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Sequester Pakistan
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FOREIGN ASSISTANCE TO PAKI-**
7 **STAN.**

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no for-
9 eign assistance may be provided to Pakistan until expendi-
10 tures for the military tuition assistance program under

1 sections 1784a and 2007 of title 10, United States Code,
2 for fiscal year 2013 are at least equal to expenditures for
3 such tuition assistance for fiscal year 2012.

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
