## A BILL

To designate a mountain ridge in the State of Montana  
as “B-47 Ridge”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “B-47 Ridge Designa-  
5       tion Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF B-47 RIDGE, MONTANA.**

2 (a) DESIGNATION.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—The unnamed mountain  
4 ridge located at  $45^{\circ}14'40.89''\text{N}$ ,  $110^{\circ}43'38.75''\text{W}$   
5 that runs south and west of Emigrant Peak in the  
6 Absaroka Range in the State of Montana, which is  
7 the approximate site of a crash of a B-47, shall be  
8 known and designated as “B-47 Ridge”.

9 (2) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law,  
10 map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of  
11 the United States to the ridge described in para-  
12 graph (1) shall be deemed to be a reference to “B-  
13 47 Ridge”.

14 (b) AUTHORIZATION FOR PLAQUE.—

15 (1) IN GENERAL.—A plaque that memorializes  
16 the crash of the B-47 (including denoting the names  
17 of the victims of the crash) may be installed on B-  
18 47 Ridge.

19 (2) FUNDING.—No Federal funds may be used  
20 to design, procure, install, or maintain the plaque  
21 authorized under paragraph (1).
