A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Defense to reprogram amounts appropriated for fiscal year 2013 for the Department of Defense for the Medium Extended Air Defense System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPROGRAMMING OF AMOUNTS FOR FISCAL**
4 **YEAR 2013 FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF DE-**
5 **FENSE FOR THE MEDIUM EXTENDED AIR DE-**
6 **FENSE SYSTEM.**

7 (a) REPROGRAMMING REQUIRED.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—To carry out section 221 of
2 the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
3 Year 2013 (Public Law 112–239; 126 Stat. 1674),
4 the Secretary of Defense shall reprogram fiscal year
5 2013 MEADS funds to other missile defense pro-
6 grams and projects that are not part of the Medium
7 Extended Air Defense System.

8 (2) REPORT.—Not later than 15 days after the
9 date on which the Secretary reprograms fiscal year
10 2013 MEADS funds under paragraph (1), the Sec-
11 retary shall submit to Congress a report describing
12 such reprogramming.

13 (b) FISCAL YEAR 2013 MEADS FUNDS DEFINED.—
14 In this section, the term “fiscal year 2013 MEADS funds”
15 means the \$380,900,000 appropriated or otherwise made
16 available by title IV of division C of the Consolidated and
17 Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2013 (Public
18 Law 113–6) under the heading “RESEARCH, DEVELOP-
19 MENT, TEST AND EVALUATION, ARMY” for the Medium
20 Extended Air Defense System.
