To amend title 49, United States Code, to prohibit a pat down search of minor for purposes of air transportation security without the consent and presence of a parent of the minor, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "TSA Screening of Mi-
- 5 nors Act of 2011".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON PAT DOWN SEARCHES OF MINORS
2	WITHOUT THE CONSENT AND PRESENCE OF
3	PARENT.
4	Section 44901 of title 49, United States Code, is
5	amended—
6	(1) by striking so much as precedes the first
7	sentence and inserting the following:
8	"(b) Screening of Passengers.—
9	"(1) Supervision of screening.—"; and
10	(2) by adding at the end the following new
11	paragraph:
12	"(2) Screening of minors.—
13	"(A) Prohibition.—A screening of a pas-
14	senger who is a minor may not include a pat
15	down search of the passenger unless such
16	search—
17	"(i) is conducted with the consent,
18	and in the presence, of a parent of the
19	minor; or
20	"(ii) in the case of a minor who is not
21	accompanied by a parent, is conducted in
22	the presence of a representative of the air
23	carrier or foreign air carrier undertaking
24	to provide air transportation or foreign air
25	transportation, respectively, for which the
26	search is conducted.

1 "(B) PARENT DEFINED.—In this para-2 graph the term 'parent' includes a person who 3 is authorized to act in loco parentis for pur-4 poses of providing consent with respect to a pat 5 down search under this section.".
