A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to reauthorize the juvenile accountability block grants program through fiscal year 2014.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Juvenile Accountability
5 Block Grants Program Reauthorization Act of 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY**
2 **BLOCK GRANTS PROGRAM THROUGH FISCAL**
3 **YEAR 2014.**

4 Part R of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and
5 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796ee et seq.) is
6 amended—

7 (1) in section 1801A(a), by striking “section
8 1810(b)” and inserting “section 1810(c)”;

9 (2) in section 1810(a), by striking “2009” and
10 inserting “2014”; and

11 (3) in section 1810(b), by inserting “and each
12 of the fiscal years 2009 through 2014” after
13 “2004”.
