AN ACT

- To direct the Secretary of Transportation to conduct a study on the costs and benefits of commuter rail passenger transportation involving transfers, and for other purposes.

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "One Seat Ride Act".
- 3 SEC. 2. STUDY ON COMMUTER SERVICE.
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Transportation
- 5 shall conduct a study identifying the benefits of commuter
- 6 rail passenger transportation and major obstacles to pro-
- 7 viding commuter rail passenger transportation that does
- 8 not involve a transfer for passengers.
- 9 (b) REQUIREMENTS.—In conducting the study under
- 10 subsection (a), the Secretary shall—
- 11 (1) consider economic, logistical, and quality of
- life factors in analyzing the major obstacles to im-
- plementing single-seat trips on commuter rail pas-
- senger transportation for as many passengers as
- possible; and
- 16 (2) include in such study an analysis of the
- 17 costs and benefits with respect to single-seat trips on
- 18 commuter rail passenger transportation on the New
- 19 Jersey Transit Raritan Valley line during peak
- 20 hours and the impact such trips would have on other
- New Jersey Transit lines.
- (c) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
- 23 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to
- 24 the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of
- 25 the House of Representatives and the Committee on

- 1 Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs of the Senate a re-
- 2 port on the study required under subsection (a).
- 3 (d) Commuter Rail Passenger Transportation
- 4 Defined.—In this section, the term "commuter rail pas-
- 5 senger transportation" has the meaning given such term
- 6 in section 24102 of title 49, United States Code.
