A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make all veterans eligible for home loans under the veterans mortgage revenue bond program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans’ Home Loan
5 Improvement Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. ALL VETERANS MADE ELIGIBLE FOR HOME LOANS**
2 **UNDER VETERANS MORTGAGE REVENUE**
3 **BOND PROVISIONS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Paragraph (4) of section 143(l)
5 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended to read
6 as follows:

7 “(4) **QUALIFIED VETERAN.**—For purposes of
8 this subsection, the term ‘qualified veteran’ means
9 any veteran who served on active duty.”.

10 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
11 this section shall apply to financing provided after the date
12 of the enactment of this Act under issues issued before,
13 on, or after such date.
