A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to prohibit 501(c)(3) organizations from providing direct funding to official election organizations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End Zuckerbucks
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. 501(c)(3) ORGANIZATIONS PROHIBITED FROM PRO-**
2 **VIDING DIRECT FUNDING TO ELECTION OR-**
3 **GANIZATIONS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
5 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

6 (1) by striking “and which does not partici-
7 pate” and inserting “which does not participate”,
8 and

9 (2) by striking the period at the end and insert-
10 ing “, and which does not provide below-cost serv-
11 ices, scholarships, subsidies, or direct, in-kind, or in-
12 direct funding to official election organizations, in-
13 cluding any State or local government entity or any
14 government election organization.”.

15 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
16 this section shall apply to funding provided in taxable
17 years beginning after December 31, 2023.

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
